### **200 Club of Bergen County Scholarship**

Four (4) scholarships at \$5,000 each are available to graduating high school seniors who is a child of an active, retired, or deceased member of Bergen County law enforcement officer, fire fighter or ambulance corps member. This also includes FBI, DEA, ATF, State Police, Palisades Interstate Commission Police, Port Authority Police, Prosecutor's Office, or Sheriff's office working in Bergen County.
