2023 JAYCEE SCHOLARSHIP FUND COMMITTEE:

A one-time award given annually to a Glen Rock resident in the amount of **\$2,000** to be used to pay for college or trade school expenses. Recipient to be selected by an “approval committee” consisting of a minimum of three Jaycee members.

“Approval committee” members must be current Jaycees, and cannot have a blood relative applying for the scholarship.

CANDIDATE SELECTION CRITERIA & PROCESS:

In the spirit of the Jaycees basic purpose, the ideal candidate will be a civic-minded individual who has demonstrated an appreciation of what Glen Rock has to offer, and has actively been involved in activities and/or organizations that have contributed to making Glen Rock a better place to live.

Selection criteria will be the following (weighted in the order shown):

1. Applicants must have demonstrated a history of productive involvement in activities and/or organizations that have as their focus the improvement of Glen Rock community life.
2. Applicants must be Glen Rock residents at the time of application, and must be graduating high school seniors in good standing.

All applications will be reviewed by the approval committee and selected at their sole discretion and as they deem appropriate. A majority of committee members must approve the winning candidate.
