

GLEN ROCK HIGH SCHOOL DANCE CONTRACT



Homecoming Dance on October 21, 2017

All students must read and agree to comply with this dance contract in order to attend any dance at Glen Rock High School. ***ONLY GLEN ROCK RESIDENTS WILL BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND THE DANCE.***

Dance Admission: \$20

General:

- School District and Student Handbook policies will apply at all times to all high school-related activities.
- Students must enter the dance at starting time.
- Students are expected to be in the dance. No loitering is allowed on the premises.
- Once students voluntarily leave the dance escorted by a parent, they may not re-enter.
- Students removed from the dance must leave the premises; no refund will be given.

Alcohol/Drugs:

- Using, being in possession of, buying, giving, accepting, selling, and/or being under the influence of alcohol, illegal drugs, or prescription drugs is prohibited as stated in the Student Handbook.
- Being in possession of any type of drug paraphernalia is also prohibited.
- If a student is suspected or determined to be under the influence of or in possession of drugs, drug paraphernalia, or alcohol, then parent and police contact will be made.

Behavior:

- Students that exhibit any behavior that is inappropriate or may potentially harm them or any student around them may be removed from the dance. Behavior that is considered inappropriate under this policy includes, but is not limited to:
 - Rubbing or other inappropriate lewd or intimate dancing or contact
 - Inappropriate touching between students, simulating sex acts, and/or any other behavior deemed disruptive by dance supervisors.
 - Partners keep hands on waist/in stomach area at all times.
 - Dancers must stay upright at all times—refrain from bending or leaning over (Hands/palms should not be able to touch mid-thigh area).
 - Dancing so tightly together as a group that a dance chaperone cannot pass freely between students.
 - Crowd surfing, moshing, or other unsafe activities.
 - Excessive display of affections.
 - Running through or around the dance area.
- This contract is considered the one and only warning for dancing inappropriately. Students who exhibit inappropriate behavior will be removed from the dance without a refund. Once a student leaves the dance, the school is not responsible for the student or her/his actions. Repeat offenders may lose all dance privileges and is also subject to school discipline.

Dress Code:

- Students are expected to be dressed appropriately according to the school's specific dress code as described in the student handbook.

I understand that failure to comply with any of the dance expectations will result in immediate removal from the dance without refund by any dance supervisor/chaperone or administrator. Furthermore, repeat offenders may lose all dance privileges to attend future dances and may also be subject to discipline at the high school.
